WELCOME TO HÄTILÄ!

Shooting sports for Reservist Associations (SRA) will celebrate its 30th anniversary next year, and the sport has significantly developed and internationalized in recent years. The military division is becoming the dominant division in the sport, which is a very positive trend considering the self-motivated equipping and situational training in combat gear by reservists. This is of paramount importance, especially in the current global situation.

Russia's barbaric attack on Ukraine has raised interest in the SRA to an unprecedented level, and I want to thank the numerous SRA activists who, through your activities, have made it possible for us to meet the demand created by the current situation.

The number of SRA shooters in Finland is approaching 15,000, and in Estonia, the number of SRA shooters has also continued to grow steadily. Sweden joined with a bang in the spring of 2022, and now Sweden already has a fully functioning SRA training organization managed by the Swedish Army's Home Guard. A concrete example of active SRA activities is that this year's SRA Finnish Championship competition will include a team from Sweden, selected in a qualifying competition last fall, where shooters sent by all Home Guard regiments competed.

Applied Reservist Shooting is a sport that teaches the most important skill of a reservist: excellent weapon handling and shooting skills. The sport develops situational, rapid, and accurate shooting skills as well as safe weapon handling. Developing these skills is of paramount importance in the prevailing global situation.

ACTION IN CASE OF EMERGENCY:

1. Report the incident
2. Rescue those in life-threatening danger
3. Prevent further damage
4. Guide the rescuers to the location
5. First aid kits are available at each stage. During the competition, a paramedic will be on standby and can be contacted through the stage personnel.

RULES AT COMPETITION AREA:

- The speed limit in the area is 35 km/h
- Competitors may only move within the competition area on the competition days, Saturday and Sunday.
- If a competitor is found in the immediate vicinity of a stage outside competition hours, they will be disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Unauthorized individuals in the area will also be reported to the military police.
- Parking is allowed only in designated areas to ensure evacuation routes are not blocked.
- Do not leave the marked road and route, especially towards the north, to avoid entering dangerous areas.
- Pets are not allowed in the competition area without the permission of the match director.
- Open fires are only allowed in designated areas.

GENERAL SITUATION

Four mechanized battle groups have disengaged from combat at the western end of road A 181, approximately 30 kilometers from the enemy's position, after two days of continuous fighting and defeating an enemy force of about two battalions, part of an attacking unit totaling four battalions. Combat capability has been restored, and attack preparations have been made.

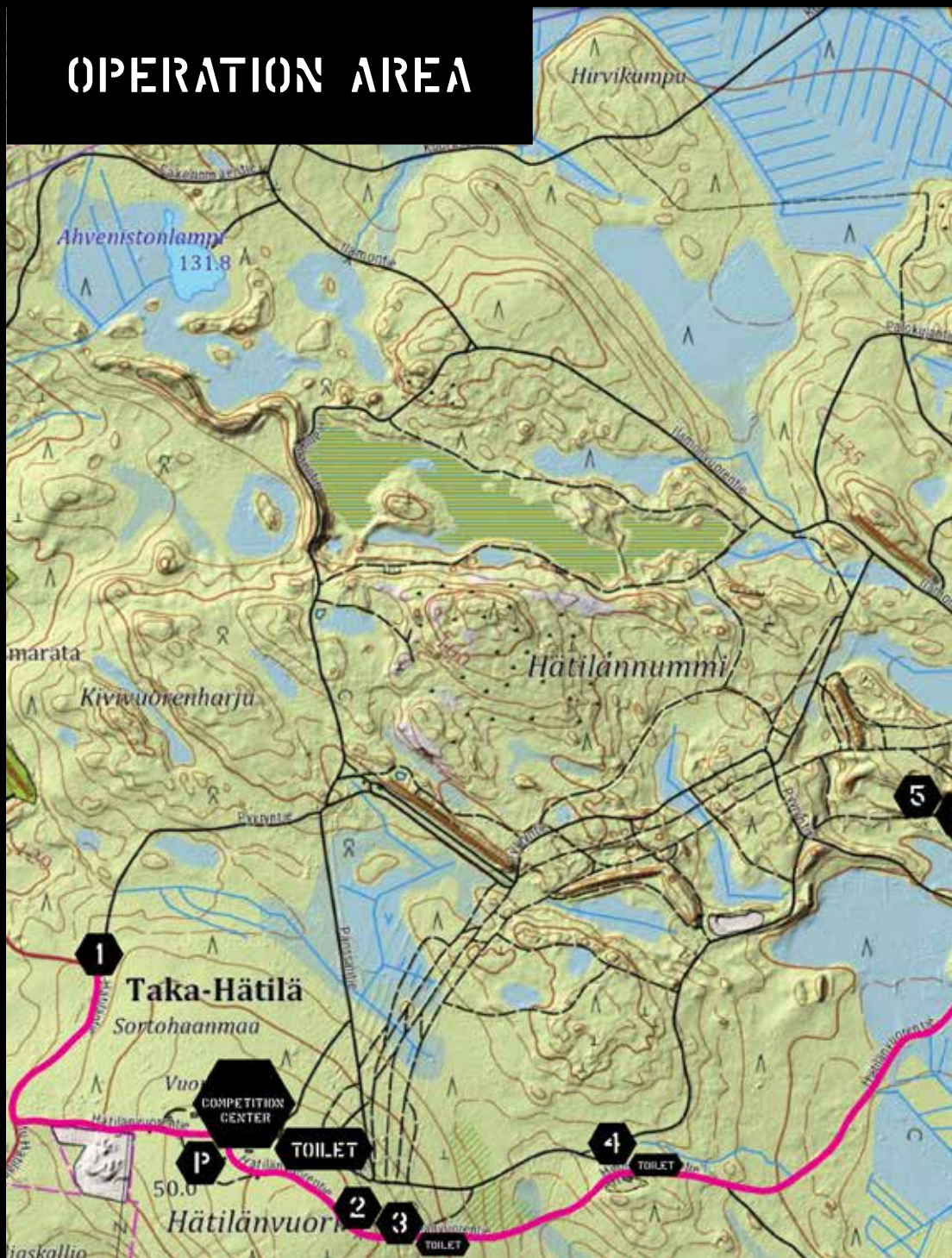
Between Portinhoikka and the next objective of the battle group, there is an enemy force of up to one infantry company. The enemy has been severely worn down in the fight with our light infantry. According to intelligence, they have lost virtually all their main battle tanks, infantry fighting vehicles and an estimated company of infantry. The enemy have been forced into a defensive position. The enemy uses drones to monitor their heavily fortified and mined surroundings. Our own battle groups 47 and 62, composed of light infantry, are encircling the enemy and keeping them under constant fire. The battle has been ongoing for four continuous days.

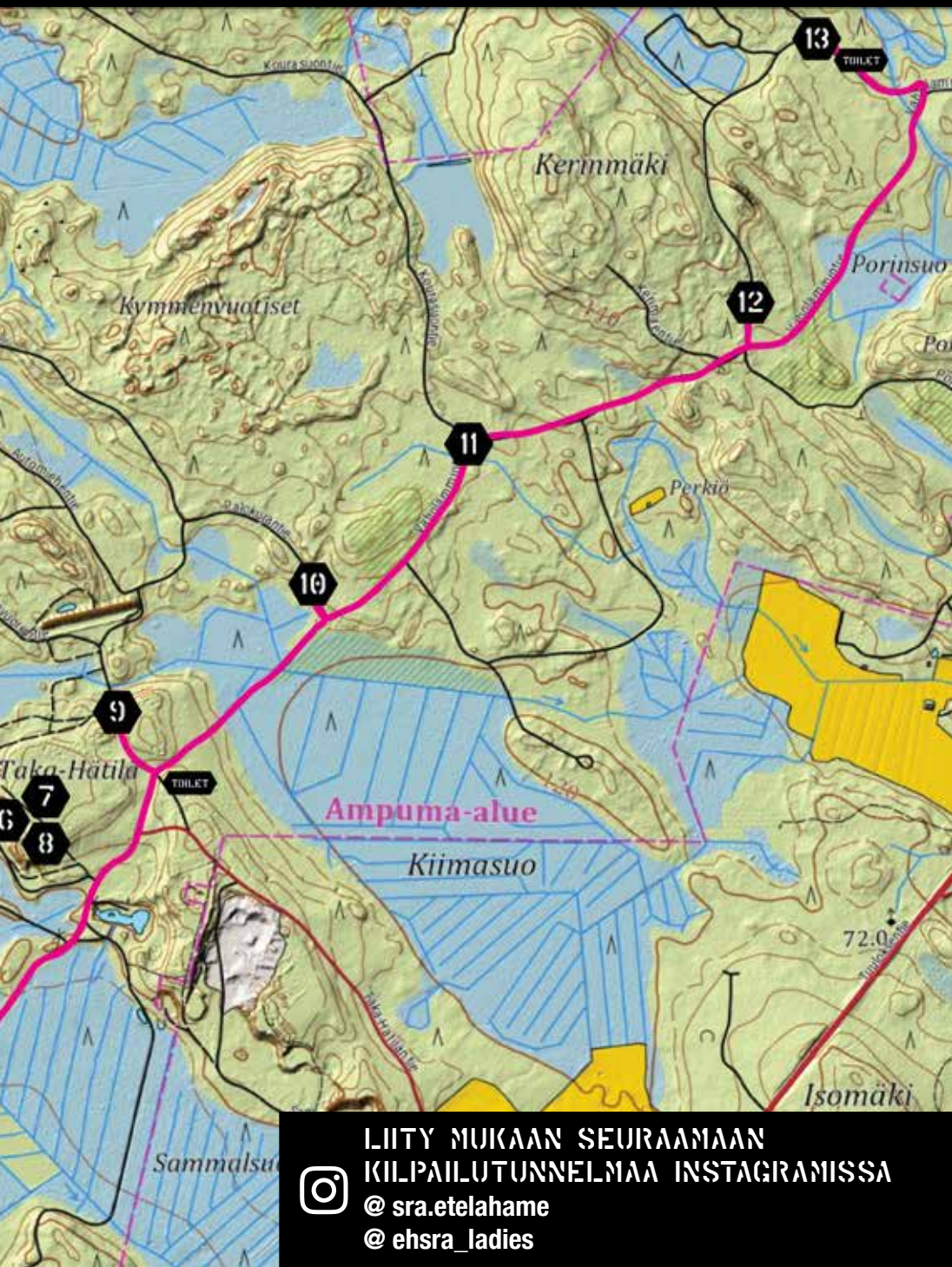
The task of the battle group is to defeat the encircled enemy, with the objective being point Z808 at the intersection of roads A 181 and 56, and to prepare to disengage along route Y22 – Y27 – Y32 to the Suur-Häme area. The battle group will attack along route A to Portinhoikka Hill, where it will connect with Battle Group 62, pass through a cleared breach, and defeat the main enemy force between Portinhoikka and the objective. Available resources include 2 rounds of heavy artillery, 3 rounds of light artillery, and one fighter mission for destroying a critical target if necessary.

Our 2nd mechanized infantry company will lead the attack of the battle group along route F, pass through the breach guided by Battle Group 62's engineer company, and defeat the encountered enemy. The objective is point Z806. Be prepared to: 1. disengage from contact under the protection of 1st mechanized infantry company along route F, 2. form a defensive position, or 3. set up a delaying action.

Time to stub out your cigarettes, ready the hand grenades, ensure you're well-stocked on ammo and make sure all four tourniquets are easily accessible. Mount up!

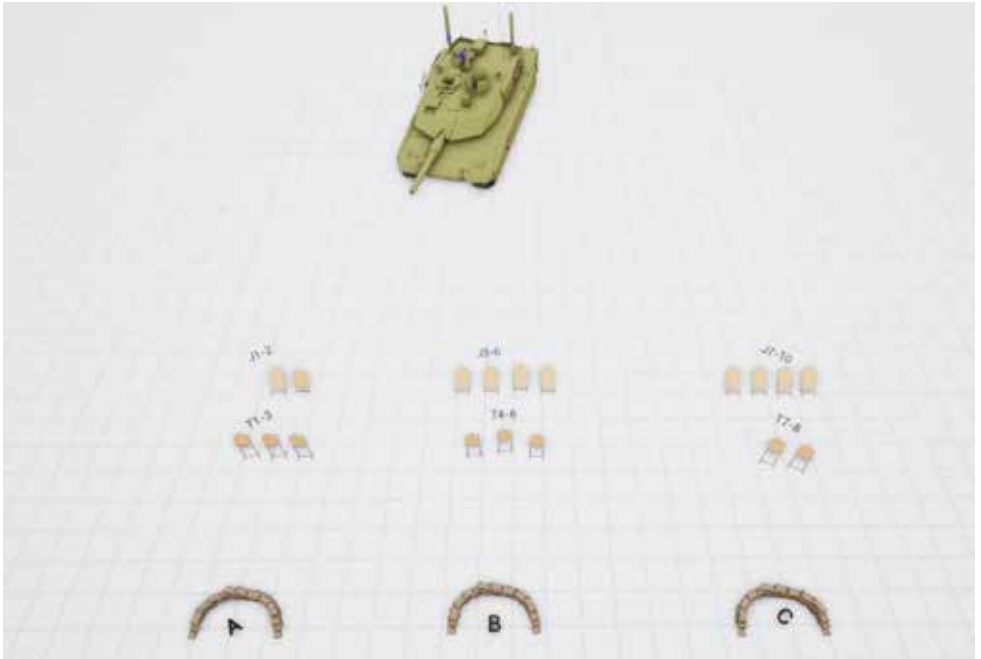


STAGE DESCRIPTIONS



SRA SM 2024

Stage 1, Rifle: A 181 road



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company is advancing towards road A 181.

ORDER: Hit the enemy

Stage has 8 SRA paper targets and 10 (5p) jaster targets.

Maximum points 130.

Shooting distance 30 - 210 m.

Minimum rounds 26.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white signs, up the upper edge of the tree stand.

Start with at least one knee on the ground from the marked spot. Rifle loaded and safety on, in hand.

At the start signal, jasters 1-2 and paper targets 1-3 are fired from area A. Jasters 3-6 and paper targets 4-6 are shot from area B. From area C, jasters 7-10 and paper targets 7-8 are shot.

Due to FDF safety regulations, you may not shoot at a distance of less than 25m with a rifle, if a competitor shoots at a distance of less than 25m, it will lead to disqualification. The range officer tries to warn about dangerous activity first. 3 minute walkthrough.

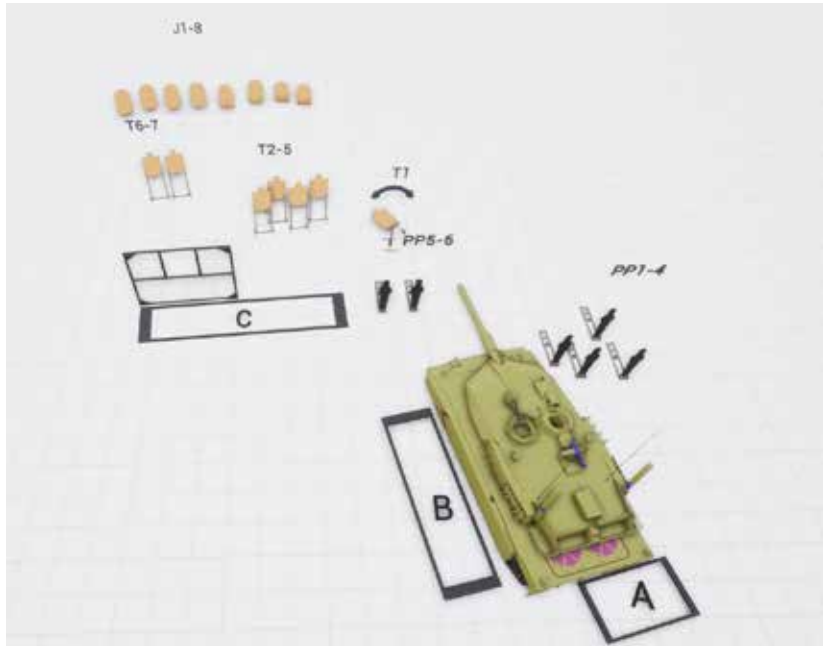

Stage 2, Rifle: Left side



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company attacks on the left wing

ORDER: Get on your feet and crush the enemy

Stage has 7 SRA paper targets (one swinger target), 6 of PP (5p), 8 jaster targets (5p).

Maximum points 140.

Shooting distance 25-300 m.

Minimum rounds 28.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white marks, up the upper edge of the perm.

Starting in the vehicle, sitting with the back on the backrest, rifle magazine attached not loaded, butt touching the floor between the legs.

At the start signal, disembark from the vehicle to area A, engage PP 1-4. The weapon can only be loaded in area A.

After that, in area B, PP 5-6, one of which triggers a swinger target. The remaining paper targets 2-7 and jasters 1-8 are shot within the sectors from area C.

Due to FDF safety regulations, you may not shoot at a distance of less than 25m with a rifle, if a competitor shoots at a distance of less than 25m, it will lead to disqualification. The range officer tries to warn about dangerous activity first.

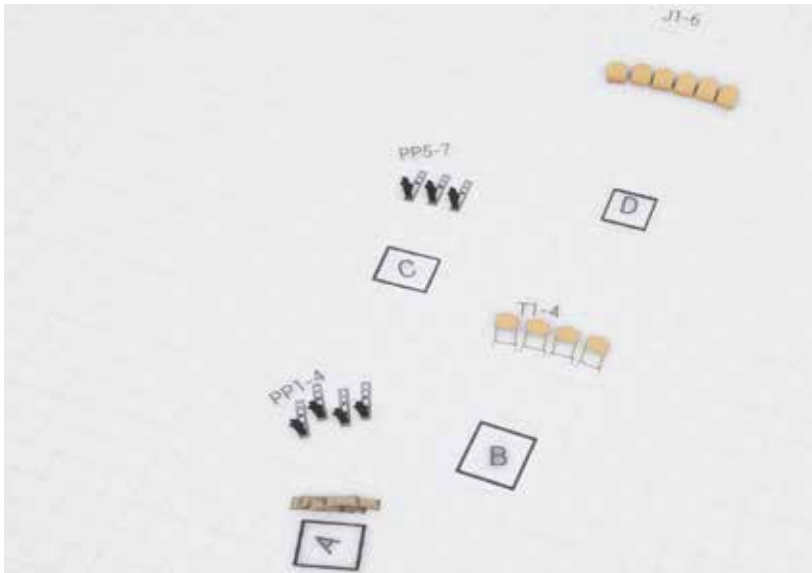

SRA SM 2024

Stage 3, Rifle: Portinhoikka



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company attacks, captures Portinhoikka hill and prepares to continue the attack in the direction of road A 181

ORDER: Advance to the objective.

Stage has 4 SRA paper targets, 7 PP (5p) and 6 jaster targets (10p)

Maximum points 135.

Shooting distance 25-250 m.

Minimum rounds 21.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white signs, up the upper edge of the perm/wood.

Starting from the marked place A on the ground, rifle in hand loaded and safety on.

From the start signal, targets are fired from area A PP1-4 and jasters 1-3. Go to area B and shoot paper targets 1-4.

Advance to area C and shoot PP 5-7. Go to area D and shoot jasters 4-6.

Due to FDF safety regulations, you may not shoot at a distance of less than 25m with a rifle, if a competitor shoots at a distance of less than 25m, it will lead to disqualification. The range officer tries to warn about dangerous activity first.

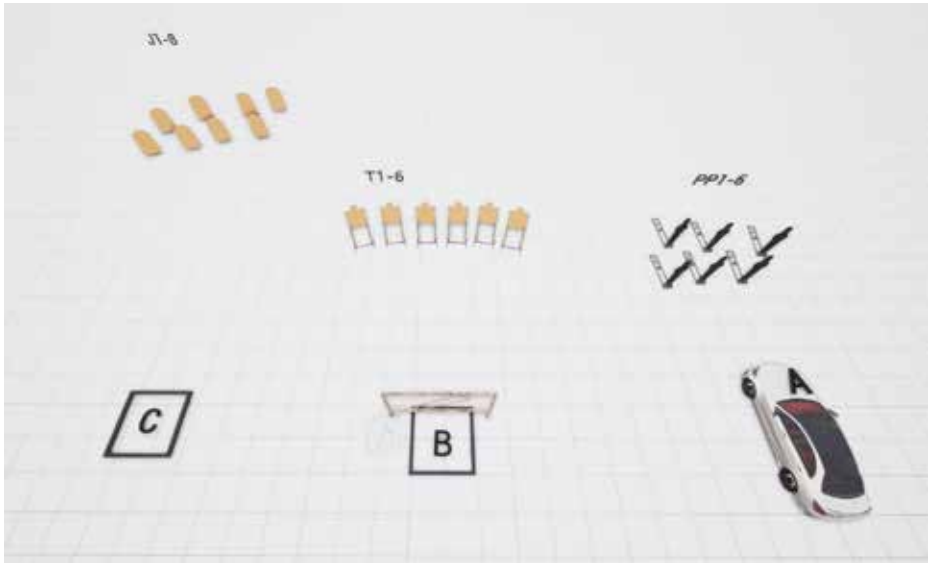

Stage 4, Rifle: Lead car



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company is moving to the target, the lead car gets hit.
ORDER: Get on your feet and crush the enemy.

Stage has 6 SRA paper targets, 6 PP (5p) and 8 jaster targets (5p).

Maximum points 130.

Shooting distance 25-60 m.

Minimum number of shots 26.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white signs, up the upper edge of the tree stand.

Starting from area A, sitting on a bench, rifle on a belt, max. 30 ptr. magazine closed, unloaded, one hand on the gun and the other on the car handle.

At the start signal, pull the handle and shoot from area A PP 1-6, from area B shoot paper targets 1-6 through the marked opening. Jasters 1-8 are fired from area C. A map must be taken from area B, which must be in the shooter's possession before the last shot is fired in area C.

If you don't bring the map with you, one procedural penalty. If the map is not in the shooter's possession in area C before the last shot is fired, one procedural penalty.

Mandatory magazine change between the first and last shot.

Mandatory safety on between shooting locations.

Hitting car structures leads to rejection and liability for compensation

Due to FDF safety regulations, you may not shoot at a distance of less than 25m with a rifle, if a competitor shoots at a distance of less than 25m, it will lead to disqualification. The range officer tries to warn about dangerous activity first. 3 minute walkthrough.

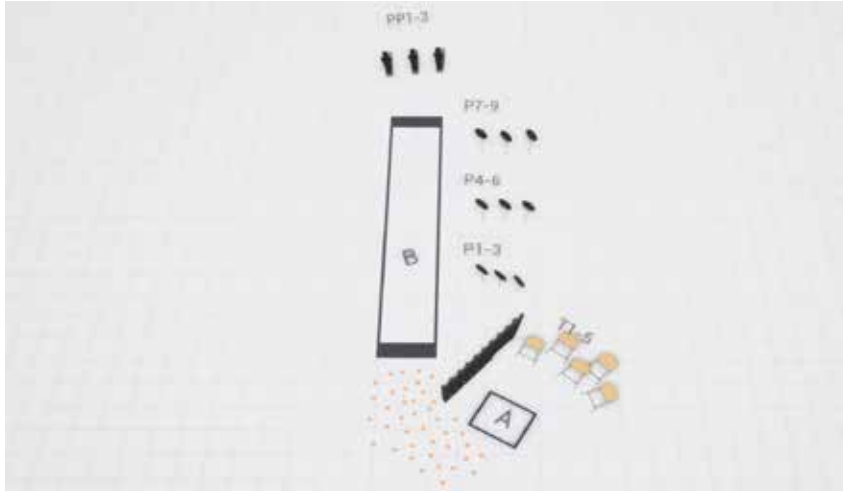

Stage 5, Pistol: Minefield



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company is on its way to the landing stage when you drive into minefield.

ORDER: Get on your feet and face the enemy

Stage has 5 SRA paper targets, 9 plates (5p), 3 PP (5p).

Maximum points 110.

Shooting distance 5-20 m.

Minimum rounds 22.

Handling sectors (follow the shooter along the road 90 degrees to the sides, up/down 90 degrees.)

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white signs, up the upper edge of the perm/wood.

Starting sitting in the vehicle, pistol unloaded in a holster.

From the start signal, paper targets, plates and PPs are shot when they are visible from areas A and B.

Mandatory magazine change between the first and last shot.

There is a minefield in the area, procedural penalty for each broken clay puck, a clay puck is broken if it is missing a piece.

A minefield is delimited by a guiding line: circling the field is a procedural penalty/clay puck.

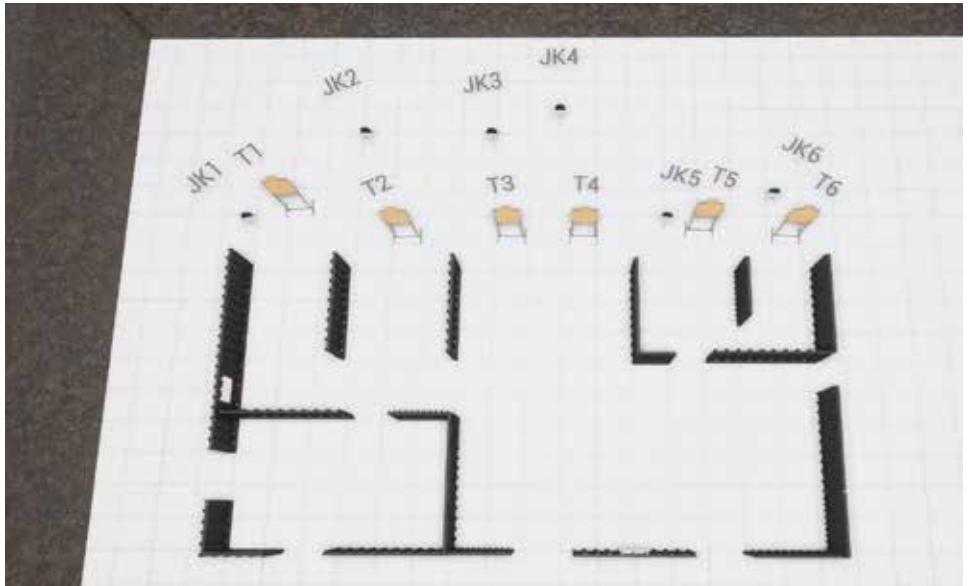

Stage 6, Rifle: Drone team



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company has located an enemy drone team.

ORDER: Destroy the team and its equipment

Stage has 6 SRA paper targets and 6 hockey pucks (5p).

Maximum points 90.

Shooting distance 5-25 m.

Minimum number of shots 18.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white marks, up the upper edge of the berm.

Start is from the marked position, standing. Rifle loaded and on safe, muzzle touching the indicated mark..

At the start signal, paper targets 1-6 and hockey pucks 1-6 are shot from area A.

Hitting the house's structures leads to disqualification and liability for compensation

3 minute walkthrough.

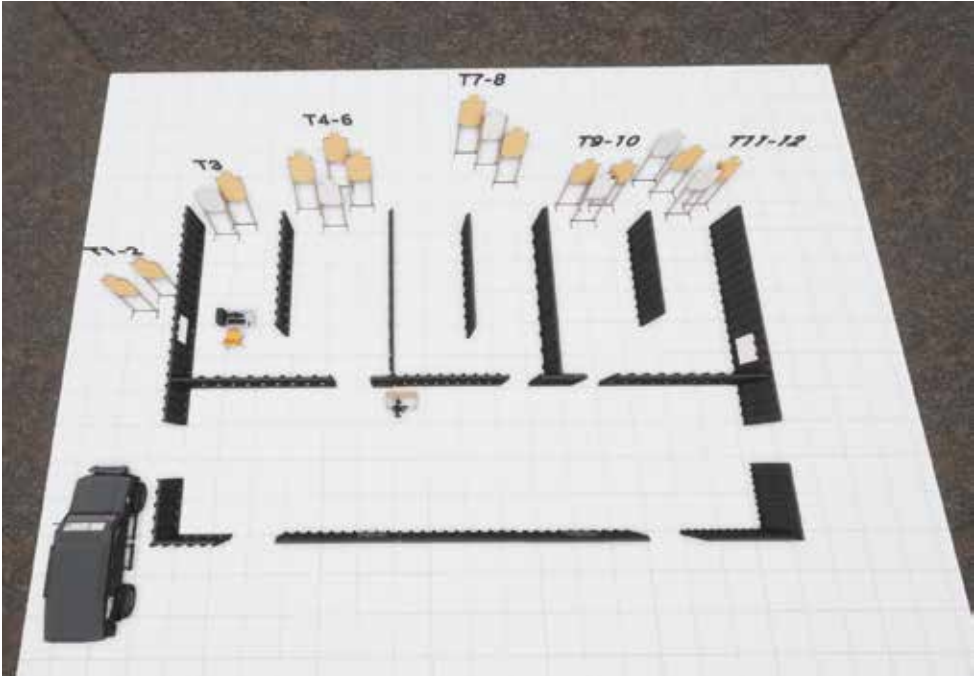

Stage 7, Pistol + Rifle: Intelligence



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company is at the command post of the enemy's drone group to obtain intelligence, the enemy makes a counterattack.

ORDER: Take the intelligence with you and break away in the direction of the green side.

Stage has 12 SRA paper targets and 6 N/S paper targets.

Maximum points 120.

Shooting distance 1-20 m.

Minimum rounds 24.

Handling sectors marked on the sides with yellow signs, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white marks, up the upper edge of the perm.

Starting on a chair, sitting with hands on the keyboard. Pistol magazine attached, unloaded, in a holster. Rifle in gun rack with magazine attached.

Start from start signal, take the memory stick and shoot paper targets 1-12 from area A.

The pistol can be left empty/safety on in the box on top of the gun rack or holstered safety on.

If you don't bring the memory stick with you, one procedural penalty.

If the memory stick is not included at the end of the Stage, procedural penalty.

Hitting the structures of the house or the car leads to rejection and liability for compensation
3 minute walkthrough.

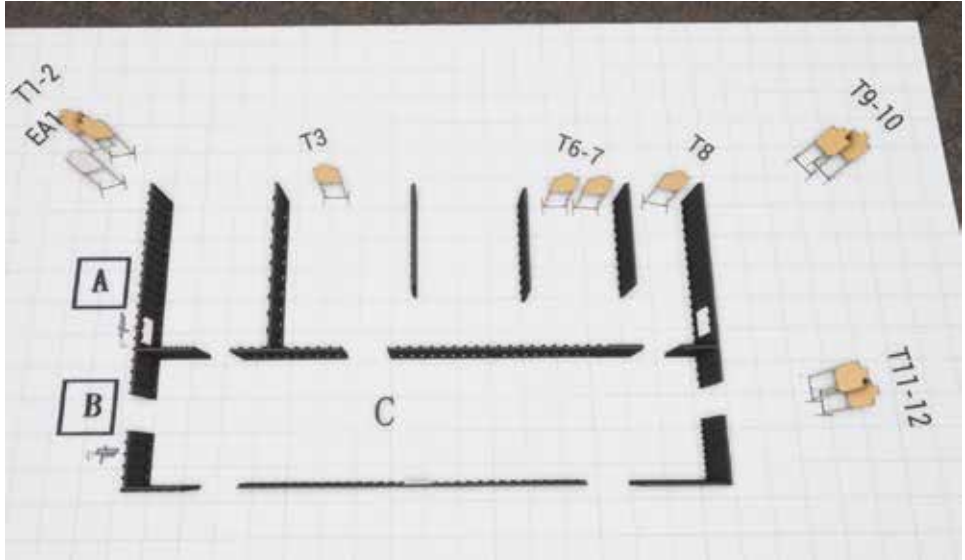

Stage 8, Rifle: Machine Gun



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company detaches from the target.

ORDER: Protect the detachment of the company.

Stage has 12 SRA paper targets, 1 N/S target.

Maximum points 120.

Shooting distance 2-25 m.

Minimum rounds 24.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white marks, up the upper edge of the perm.

Start: From area A, gun loaded, aiming at the target. Grenade launcher at the marked location.

At the start signal, targets T1-2 are fired from area A. Pick up the grenade launcher, move to area B and shoot the grenade through the marked hole. Place the grenade launcher at the marked place. Targets T3-12 are shot from area C. You can leave the rifle in the marked place while firing the grenade. The rifle must be safety on while handling the grenade launcher.

If the launcher is not fired, procedural penalty is awarded. If the launcher is not taken from the marked place, procedural penalty. If the launcher is not placed at the marked place in the indicated manner, procedural penalty is awarded.

Hitting the house's structures leads to rejection and liability for compensation
3 minute walkthrough.

Stage 9, Sniper rifle: Aiming point 'Echo-Vector'



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company is grouped in defense. The support patrol secures the road on the eastern side.

ORDER: Defeat the enemy and prevent the use of the roadway.

There are 10 jaster targets (10p).

Maximum points 100.

Shooting distance 250-300 m.

Minimum rounds 10.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

In the trench, handling sector is 360 degrees with the BARREL pointing DOWNWARDS TO THE TRENCH

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white marks, up the upper edge of the perm, down the lower edge of the perm.

Starting position in area A, Sniper rifle loaded and safety on, aiming at the target.

Targets are shot after the start signal from areas A, B and C when visible. Mandatory safety on when moving between areas A-B-C.

Hitting the structures of the entrenched base leads to rejection and liability for compensation.

3 minute walkthrough.

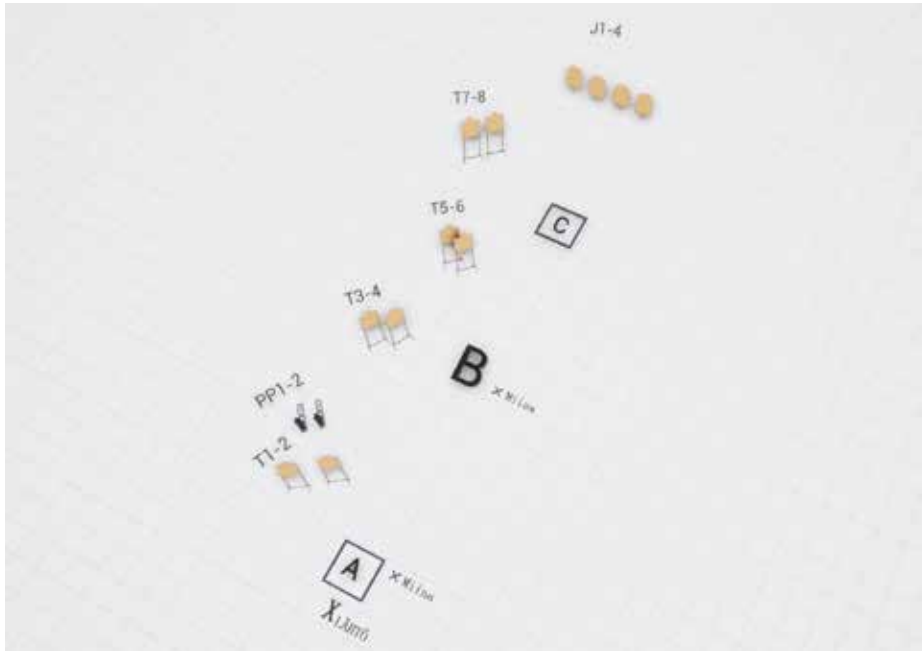

Stage 10, Pistol: Palokuja



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company delays the enemy in the direction of Palokuja by mining the area.

ORDER: implement BACKUP PLAN 3.

Stage has 8 SRA paper targets, 2 PP (Sp) and 4 jaster targets (Sp)

Maximum points 110.

Shooting distance 2-25 m.

Minimum rounds 22.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white signs, up the upper edge of the tree stand.

Starting from the marked place, mines in both hands. Pistol loaded and safety on in a holster.

At the start signal, targets 1-2 and PP 1-2 are fired from area A. Move to area B, where paper targets 3-6 will be shot within the sectors, from area C paper targets 7-8, jasters 3-6 will be shot. Deliver the mines (2 pcs) in place before the last shot.

If both wire mines are not taken to area A, procedural penalty/mine. If one mine is not taken to at least area B, procedural penalty/ mine. Hitting the moose tower with structures leads to rejection and liability for compensation.

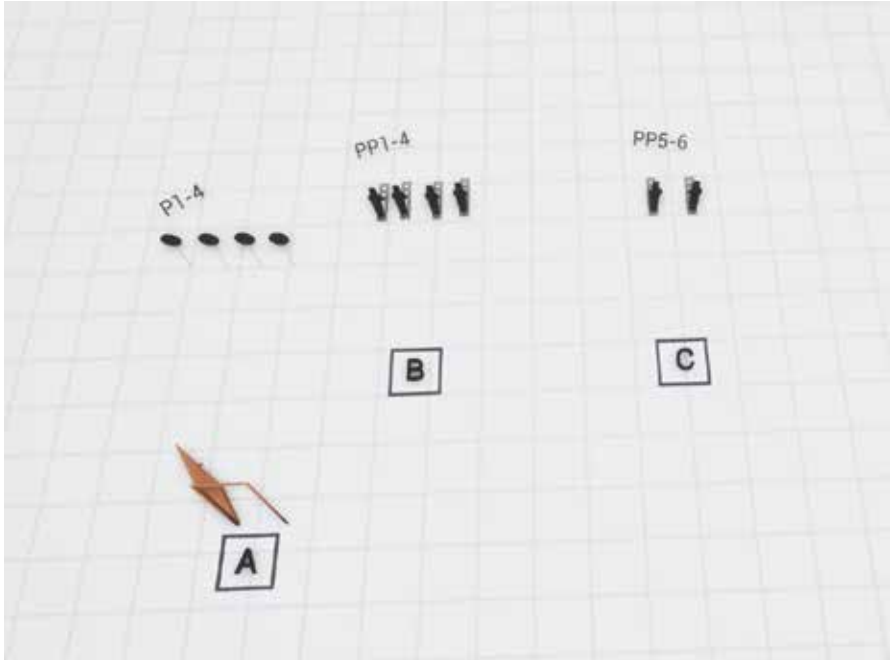

Stage 11, Shotgun: Command post



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company will take over the area and the buildings there.

ORDER: Take over the enemy's command post.

Stage has 4 clay discs (5p) and 6 PP (10p).

Maximum points 80.

Shooting distance 0-25 m.

Minimum rounds 11.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white signs, up the upper edge of the perm/wood.

Start at position A standing, shotgun loaded, barrel pointing to the marked position.

At the start signal, door/hatch hinge is fired from location A and P1-4 through the doorway. PP1-4 is fired from area B and PP5-6 from area C.

If the hinge is not shot, one procedural penalty.

Max shotgun pellet size 3mm.

3 minute walkthrough.

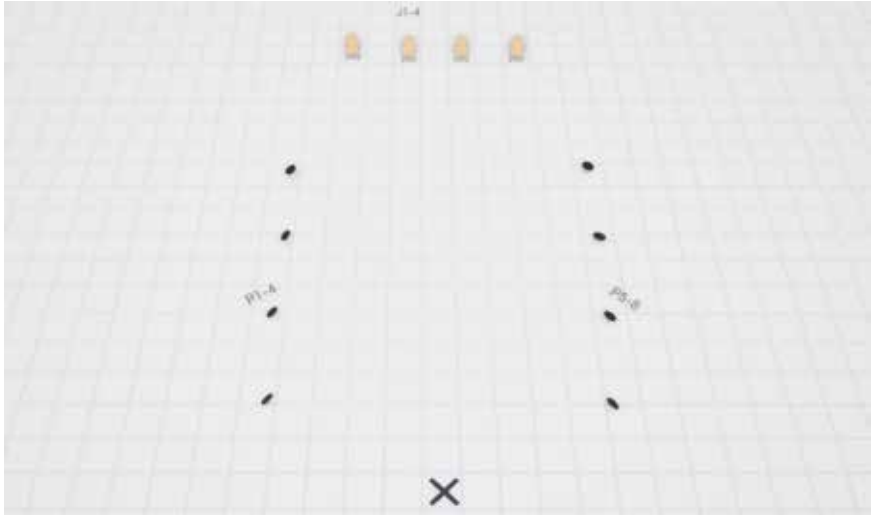

SRA SM 2024

Stage 12, Shotgun: Air threat



SITUATION: The 3rd group of the 2nd mechanized infantry company protects the team from drone reconnaissance when an enemy patrol strikes.

ORDER: Identify and hit the enemy.

Stage has 8 plates (5p) and 4 jaster targets (10p).

Max. points: 80.

Shooting distance: 8-35 m.

Minimum number of shots: 12.

Handling sectors: Marked on the sides at the beginning, follow the shooter, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white signs, up the upper edge of the tree stand.

Start with one knee on the ground. Shotgun loaded and safety on.

At the start signal, the targets are shot with a shotgun when they are visible.

Before the last shot, the enemy's sleeve badges are taken over.

Penalties: If two enemy sleeve badges are not in possession before the last shot, procedural penalty/missing sleeve badge is awarded. If you don't try to take over the badges, one procedural penalty.

Max shotgun pellet size is 3mm.

3 minute walkthrough.

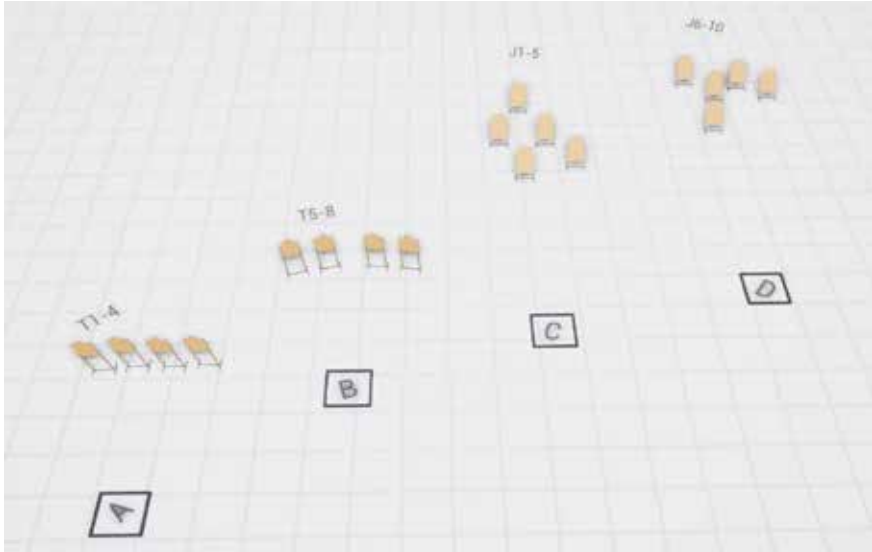

Stage 13, Rifle: Counterattack



SITUATION: 2nd mechanized infantry company is grouped for a counterattack, with the aim of knocking the enemy out of their positions.

ORDER: Open fire from my mark, then charge!

Stage has 8 SRA paper targets and 10 jaster targets (5p).

Maximum points 130.

Shooting distance 25-150 m.

Minimum rounds 26.

Handling sectors marked on the sides, up and down 90 degrees.

The shooting sectors are marked on the sides with orange-white signs, up the upper edge of the perm/wood.

Starting from area A, rifle loaded and safety on, barrel touching the mark.

At the start signal, paper targets 1-4 are shot from area A and paper targets 5-8 from area B. Jasters 1-5 are shot from area C and jasters 6-10 from area D.

Due to FDF safety regulations, you may not shoot at a distance of less than 25m with a rifle, if a competitor shoots at a distance of less than 25m, it will lead to disqualification. The range officer tries to warn about dangerous activity first. 3 minute walkthrough.
