**The South Häme reservist organizations will organize the
Hätilä25 SRA Competition on July 18, 2026
at the Hätilä shooting range in Hämeenlinna.**

The competition is now being organized for the 15th time.

The competition will consist of 7 rounds:

4 Rifle rounds

2 Rifle + Pistol combination rounds

1 Pistol round

Address of the competition center: Panssaritie 5, Hämeenlinna.



Please note that the route to the area is via Ruunumyllyntie and Etu-Hätiläntie. The navigation systems will guide you towards Panssaritie from several wrong directions, which will lead you to a road that is cut off by a locked barrier. The speed limit in the competition area is 35km/h.

If you choose the wrong group, you can also change the group yourself as follows: On the main page, select “Competitors” -> “Your name” -> “Delete” the group you selected and then select a new group.

If the competitor is a foreign citizen, the following information must be provided: First name, last name, rank/profession, (organization, you can put res etc.) nationality and passport number.

If you are not traveling with a passport, another ID card will also work.

If the fee has not been paid by 28th of June you will lose your place and it will be given to the next person in line. The competition fee is not refunded, but if you are unable to participate, you can resell your place. You must notify the competition organizers via SSI (who will replace you, class and series(s))

You can see your status via SSI:

Waiting = Waiting for a competition place

Pending = Waiting for competition fee (1st status update on 21st of June. and every few days thereafter)

Approved = Paid competition place, right to choose a group.



Calibers and cartridges used

The rifle calibers allowed in the competition are .223, 7.62×39, 9x19 and .300 BLK. Pistol caliber 9mm.

Note! For safety reasons, the bullet weight of the .223 cartridge is limited to max. 55gr. Also, the use of steel core and light stripes in cartridges is prohibited. This restriction significantly affects, among other things, the shooting sectors and therefore this restriction is used in the competition. If a shooter uses prohibited cartridges, it will result in disqualification. The imposed restriction allows for more sectors and enables the construction of more diverse controls and the placement of targets.

Award categories and series

The competition will award prizes to the top 3 in the following categories: TST, Open and Standard, and in the following categories: Y50, Y60, 7.62×39, Women and Newcomer. Prizes will be awarded if there are at least 5 participants in the category/category at the end of the registration period. Registration for all categories/category must be done in advance through SSI.

7.62×39

A 7.62 series shooter must shoot the competition with a 7.62×39 caliber rifle.

Newcomer

A newcomer can participate in the series if they have received an SRA card within 2 years.

(SRA status obtained after 1.1.2024)

General / At the competition center

Upon arrival at the competition, the competition center will check the SRA shooter's card or other certificate, insurance, and shooter's categories and possible series. The shooter must have a valid RUL/RES/MPKL shooting insurance or SAL competition license.

During the award ceremony, prizes will be drawn among all those present, so it is worth staying there.

The competition center will also have **Babylicious Catering** selling tasty food, so while waiting for the results, you can eat and also check out the offerings of **AAWEE:n**, **Taisteluväline**, **Kurre**, **StellArmor**, **Korppi Gear**, **Montoolgear**, **Motti Co.**, **Nortac**, **Origopro**, **Peltonen Knives**, **Sisutac ja Trueaim**. Inside the canteen building, there is also an equipment flea market where you can find bargains. A military van will also visit the area, more detailed information in the competitor interview. Controls will be filmed, so if you do not

want to appear in the competition video, please inform the officials at the competition center when checking the insurance.

Competition hours are on Friday and Saturday from 0800 to 1800, after which the competition activities are suspended and are interpreted as free time for the officials, meaning that after this time they can, for example, leave.
